The People for Channahon Park Foundation has launched a capital campaign initiative to develop the Arroyo Trails Project as a location for children, adults and families to "Discover Nature, Learn Through Play, and Have Outdoor Fun".

We anticipate this new park, featuring many Nature Based Educational Programs offered throughout the year, will serve thousands of children and adults annually on the 78 acres of woodlands and grasslands of the trail. This includes: summer camps; special events; scout group programs; interpretive signage and opportunities for children to learn through play.

The total anticipated cost to build the Arroyo Trails Project is estimated at \$2,000,000. Over the past several months, the Foundation Board has raised close to \$1M in lead gifts to help with initial funding and break ground on the project. We are now launching a Comprehensive Community Campaign to raise the balance of funding needed for this outstanding outdoor treasure.
